ABSTRACT

Nur Hafshah Idris, 2022. Students' Perceptions about Online English Learning During the Covid-19 Pandemic: Learning for class XII Science 2 Students of SMA Negeri 1 Serui, (supervised by Nasmilah dan Abidin Pammu).

Perception begins with attention from within a person in the form of a selective attention process using the senses. The purpose of this study is to explain student perceptions, obstacles faced by students, and solutions to overcome the problem of online English learning during the COVID-19 pandemic at SMA Negeri 1 SERUI.

The current research is quantitative research with descriptive analysis. The population in this study was 34 students of XII Science 2 at SMA Negeri 1 Serui. Sampling technique using total sampling. The sample used in this study consisted of 24 responses, with a total of 15 question items. The data collection procedure uses the distribution of questionnaires using Google forms and data analysis techniques. This study uses simple descriptive statistics in analyzing student perceptions.

The results of the study confirmed that the students had a perception of online English learning during the COVID-19 pandemic. In class XII, Science 2, has a good perception of online English learning. They understand the online learning material very well, including the way the material is being delivered, which to them is very interesting. The students admit that this online English learning mode is very effective.

ABSTRAK

Nur Hafshah Idris,2022. Persepsi Siswa Terhadap Pembelajaran Bahasa Inggris Online Di Masa Pandemi Covid-19 : Pembelajaran Pada siswa kelas XII IPA 2 Di SMA Negeri 1 Serui, (dibimbing oleh Nasmilah dan Abidin Pammu).

Persepsi diawali dengan perhatian dari dalam diri seseorang berupa proses perhatian yang selektif dengan menggunakan alat indra. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk memaparkan persepsi siswa, kendala yang dihadapi oleh siswa, dan solusi untuk mengatasi permasalahan pembelajaran bahasa Inggris secara online selama pandemic Covid-19 di SMA Negeri 1 SERUI.

Jenis penelitian ini merupakan peneliitian kuantitatif dengan analisis deskriptif. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah 34 siswa IPA XII 2 di SMA Negeri 1 Serui. Teknik pengambilan sampel dengan menggunakan total sampling. Sampel yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini sebanyak 24 responde dengan jumlah item pertanyaan 15 item. Adapun prosedur pengumpulan data dengan menggunakan bantuan google form dan teknik analisis data penelitian ini menggunakan statistik deskriptif sederhana dalam menganalisis persepsi siswa.

Hasil dari penelitian diketahui bahwa mayoritas siswa memiliki persepsi terhadap pembelajaran bahasa inggris online di masa pandemic covid-19 kelas XII IPA 2 mendapat respon baik. Mayoritas siswa banyak memahami materi pembelajaran daring yang disampaikan, cara penyampaian materi yang sangat menarik. Serta pendapat siswa mengenai pembelajaran daring yang dianggap sangat efektif.
