A :	actually, kampung inggris pare not selling the knowledge or method, they selling the environment, a whole place is filled with hundreds or more student that have the same ambition to know how to speak english well, from the course i took, the good method is their disciplinary to speak english, we have to speak in english all the time even with our roommates (they usually strolling around for checking), the result actually different, compare to my learning environment in my hometown, i am getting used to write in english, especially for academic purpose, but in pare, they made us brave to speak and getting used to hear english in society

A :	So, what I know before went to Pare is, Pare is the village that almost all the citizens spoke only in English. But in fact, that is just a village who is a lot of English courses places. Why I choose Pare, because none of it was personally planned. At that time my high school classmate invited us via WA group chat. Then, it was just the three of us who went there.

A :	Actually it depends on the teacher. My teacher from Elementary school until high school maybe just so-so for me. So, actually my english speaking capabilities not really improved. However, I learned more by myself.

	Greatly Improved. Because, everyday from morning to night we only study English. In the dormitory itself for fellow residents. If not, we will receive punishment such as a fine or cleaning the dorm
Q :	what are the differences of methods and result did you experience after studying in kampung inggris compared to your previous learning environment?
A :	As an English Literature student, learning English itself is no longer too strict because all students who want to enter this department must already know the basics of English. However, we were accustomed to using English



	starting from conversations between students and lecturers to materials that presented on the class. Meanwhile in Pare, we study English very casually yet a lil bit strict because we study from AM to PM. And also in one class not everyone know English from beginning, so that's why everything starts from the beginning and is done strictly
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3) Alumni 3 :

Q :	what do you know about formal and non-formal learning context?
A :	Okay, as far as I know, formal learning context is formal learning that we get from school. Which is structured, has a curriculum, and is regulated by an institution. While non-formal learning is learning that we get from our surroundings, especially from parents. What we get from parents, what we get from our surroundings, without any special curriculum that regulates it, without any special rules that regulate it. Yes, I think that's all.
Q :	what do you know about kampung inggris pare? and why you chose kampung inggris pare for your non-formal learning?
A :	Kampung Inggris Pare, as far as I know, is an area or a village where there are many language courses. Especially English. Actually, not only English. There are many languages too, for example Arabic, Mandarin is also available. But the dominant language is English. And why did I choose Kampung Inggris for my non-formal learning? Because, as far as I know before going there, there we really speak English 24 hours a day. So, in my opinion, with my limited English skills, it will really help me develop my



	self-confidence to be able to speak English all day long. That's it.
Q :	can you explain how formal learning (campus/school) affects your speaking fluency?
A :	For me, learning English at school or on campus is not very effective. Because, especially for me, the fun of learning English depends on the teacher. For example, when I was in junior high school, I got a good teacher and I liked it, I started to like learning English, but when I was in high school, the teacher was not so good. So, learning English became very boring. I felt like running away, and my ability did not develop at all. Especially for speaking, it was because I rarely spoke. When I was in junior high school, I often did speaking activities. But when I was in high school, because the teacher rarely came, the teacher only gave assignments, so my speaking ability was not so good.
Q :	OK, so your speaking ability is in accordance with the environment or teacher who teaches, isn't it?
A :	Yes, whether it is fun or not depends on the teacher. Even in campus, we often speak English, but it's in class. It's not always like that. But in the environment of the campus, speaking outside of class is quite rare to speak English. Even with my friends with the same English major. So, it's not too effective outside of class.
	what did you get from kampung inggris on your speaking improvement?





A :	<p>Okay, so, yesterday when I was in Kampung Inggris Pare, actually, I took an English course that was specifically for speaking for two weeks only, the rest was grammar. So, what helped the most was when I was at the English camp, I happened to join the English language camp. Because there, we can choose whether to join the English language camp or not. I chose to join the English language camp only, but because I joined the English language camp, there were also many speaking classes like before going to bed, at dawn, and at night too. At night and before going to bed are different. So, at the camp, maybe, as we know, if we don't speak English, we will be fined. So, it really helps to always free yourself, force yourself to speak. Like words that have been forgotten, forced to be remembered. And, before I went there, people said that even the sellers, people outside the course, they speak English. It turns out not all of them, only a few, rarely find people who can speak English. So, it really helped when I was at the English camp. That was the most effective.</p>
Q :	<p>Okay, so the impact of the camp is that your English speaking fluency is getting better, isn't it?</p>
A :	<p>yes at that time, because the environment was very supportive there because everyone spoke English. But when I returned home, honestly everything was gone. Back again because of the environment, at the beginning I actually still often communicated with friends at night like zoom meetings to keep</p>



	making a conversation to keep improving, but only a few moments after that it was no longer the case, communication had started to disappear, we were no longer conversation and no longer speaking English and what's more I was forgetful, so my memory slowly disappeared
Q :	what are the differences of methods and result did you experience after studying in kampung inggris compared to your previous learning environment?
A :	Yes, as I said earlier, after studying there, compared to the method and the results, because in Kampung Inggris, the environment is English. So, we are used to it and have a habit of speaking English. However, the learning environment before, on campus or at school, we only spoke English when we were in class. Because there, even if we chat in the room, in the bedroom, or wherever we speak English. So, the effects and results are already familiar.
Q :	When in Kampung Inggris, the results are very different from when on campus, isn't it?
A :	Yes, it is very different, because at school or on campus, what is it? We only learn when we meet the teacher, we only speak English when there is an assignment to speak English, it is not that we never speak English to each other, but it is quite rare to speak English, only sometimes, but it is not like in Kampung Inggris.

A :	I chose the English village of Pare because there we can learn fluently and there communication is in English every day so I am interested in studying there because the learning there is in English every day

Q :	with the learning method, maybe it can be helped from you to explain specifically, such as the study time in a day, and as I know, after class there is usually learning in the dormitory or what is usually called camp. maybe the experience felt can be explained?
A :	The duration at school is shorter, which is only 90 minutes, whereas in Kampung Inggris Pare, I go to class from 8 am to 12 noon and then continue from 1 pm to 6 pm, which makes us more focused.

	For dormitory learning, it depends on the individual, if you want to look for additional lessons, it will be easy to get them.



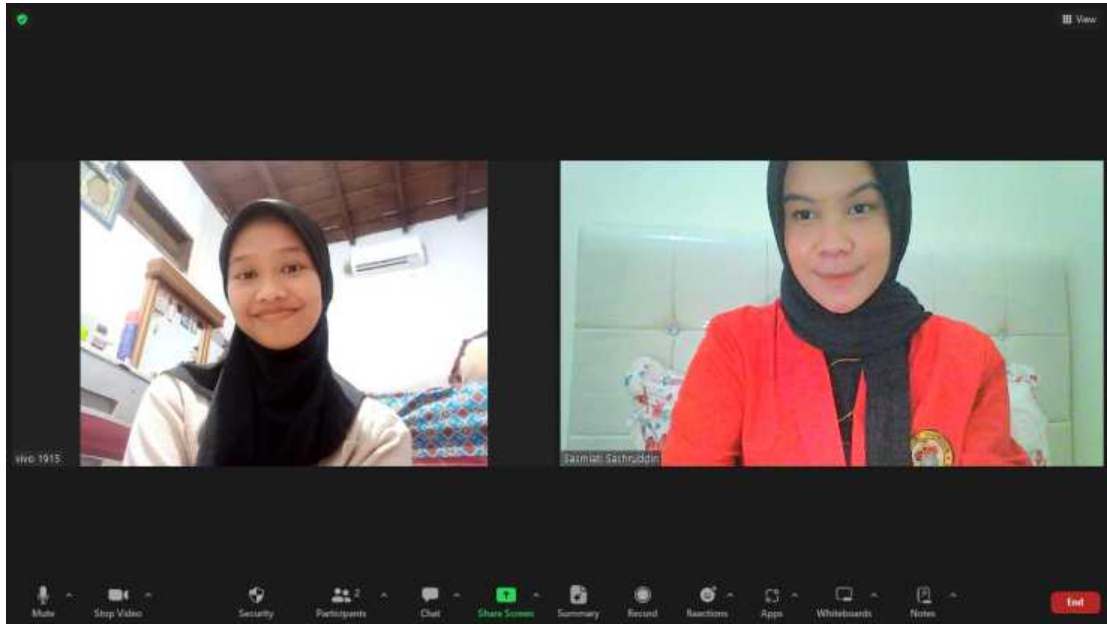
Q :	Talking about impact, are there any positive impacts brought from Kampung Inggris Pare to everyday life?

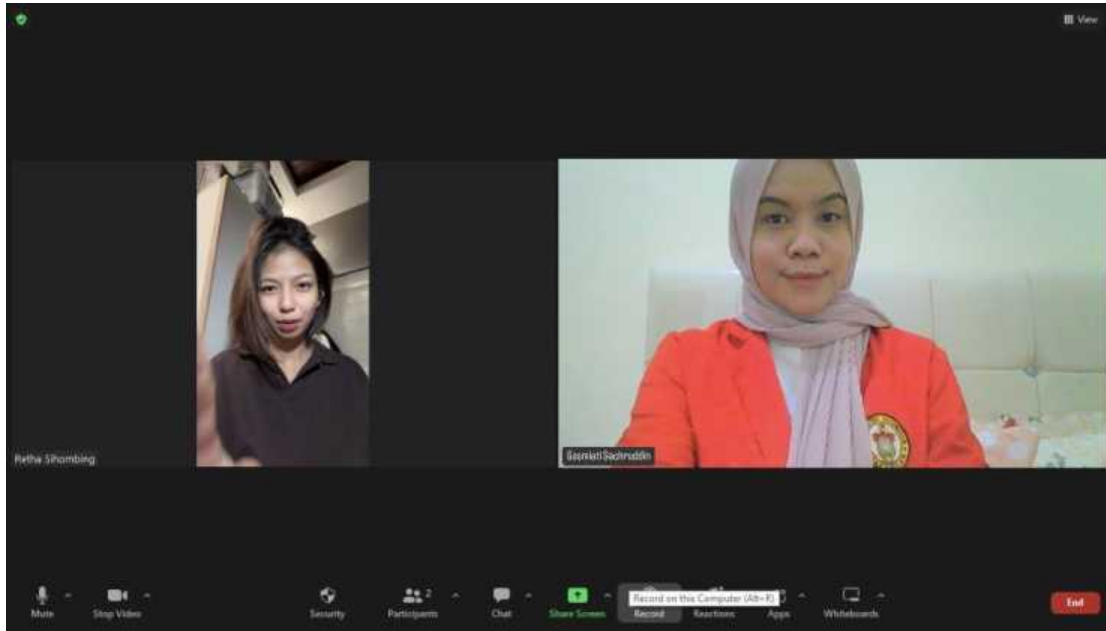
