Justin Bieber on The Ellen Show

Justin : : She always looks great

Ellen : did other people bring things, or did she make it for everybody?

Justin : Everybody kind of brought an item, and I have a chef too, which I'm really blessed about to have.

Ellen : So did Haley cook that turkey? Or your chef cooked it and she posed with it.

Justin : No, Hailey actually did.

Ellen : Oh, she.. okay.

Justin : Yeah.

Ellen : That's great. Well, you're lucky that she's a good cook and that she likes to cook.

Justin : Yeah, I really am.

Ellen : I'm looking at your beautiful new tattoo, and I saw the documentary, which I loved, but I know what this means. But explain what the rose means to you.

Justin : Well, the rose is kind of like I guess, to be honest, I made up a meaning because, really, I just like the way it looks, but it's kind of like finding the beauty within. Kind of like the roughness of like it's on the other side.

Ellen : This is the chicken doing Havana. You can do it, though.

Camila : Easy.

Ellen : Yeah, perfect.. So many questions. It's really good. But I'm wondering, do you think that he yeah. You performed New Year's Eve in New York, and it was freezing. **Have you ever sung with that kind of weather before where it's like below zero?**

Camila : **I had never and worst, I'm from Miami, so that's just not great.** It's not.

Ellen : Okay.

Camila : No, it's not. And there was a negative 100 degree wind chill. That's crazy.

Ellen : That's not right.

Camila : That's awesome.

Ellen : You're not right in that. I'm sorry. There's no way it's a negative 100. Maybe it was just word of mouth.

Camila : Yeah. And I've just been saying it to kind of..

Ellen : you would have dramatize my point. You would have died. Negative 100 degree.

Camila : Yeah, no, it was like negative 30 with windchill, I think. But that doesn't sound as like oh, sure it does.

Ellen : You're right.

Camila : Yeah.

Ellen : No need to exaggerate.

Camila : Negative 30. Got it.

Ellen : So what does that do to your vocal cords when you're singing with freezing cold?

Camila : Well, during the soundtrack, I couldn't feel my chin, so I was like.. but I had hand warmers, and I put them like I was wearing two layers of clothing or like, three layers of clothing because, okay, I'm from Miami, I can't do the negative 30, negative 100, whatever. It's not going to happen. So I put them everywhere and I put them right here. And it helps a lot. It helps a lot because I feel like, first of all, it was great. And I don't know why, but it was great. And I couldn't put them on my toes because then it makes the shoe uncomfortable. And this was like, the only place that I could do it.

Ellen : So you put them in your underwear.

Camila : So I put it, like, right above my underwear, but underneath my pants. Yeah, it was great. And so I was out there just Havana.

Ellen : So you felt the heat there and it made you think of Havana.

Camila : Yeah, exactly.

Ellen : Yes, I understand that.

Camila : Yeah, I think I'll do that anytime I perform a negative 30 degree or just when it's in general.

Ellen : Yeah, I'm wearing some now.

Camila : Nice.

Ellen : Killing it.

Camila : Nobody knows.

Ellen : It's okay. They know now. They know. Maybe that'll be like the new thing that everybody wears warmers down there.

Camila : Down there.

Ellen : Let's find out if anyone has done that before we'll ask people to write in mom.

Camila : Okay.

Ellen : All right.. You come back anytime and I love your new song. I love the album. It's doing great. Congratulations on everything. You're doing it.

Ellen : No.

Justin : But I'm glad it worked out because she's an amazing person.

Ellen : Yeah, she seems like it.

Justin : She really is. She's super precious. I enjoy spending my life with her.

Ellen : Yeah, and it's cute because you all talk about how you still get nervous when you're around her. She gets nervous and that's adorable

Justin : Yeah. That's going to go away right now.

Ellen : When you proposed to her, were you really super nervous? Did you know what you were going to say? Was it like a romantic gesture?

Justin : Yeah, I felt like in the past, we had talked about me asking the question, and I felt like she would say yes, so I wasn't really nervous about saying yes, but I think I was more nervous about **am I going to make this commitment?** Am I able to make this commitment as a man and be able to honor what I say? Because that's a serious commitment. When you say you're going to love someone for better, for worse and be faithful, that's a huge am I able to do that? Ellen : All right, **so do you think the turning point was when you got on stage at Coachella with Ariana that made you think that's a turning point?**

Justin : I think I'd been just so afraid for some reason. I think we all, as humans, get caught upon this place of fear, just whatever we're dealing with, we're all dealing with fear to some degree. And in that place in my life, I was just battling a lot of stuff internally, and so I was just afraid. I was afraid of what people were thinking, afraid of, can I do this again? Ellen : Yeah. All right we're going to play a game when we come back.

Demi Lovato on The Ellen Show

Ellen : You.. You look fantastic. And there's pictures of you in Vanity Fair that are boy, oh, boy, they're naked. Naked. They are. Okay, so now that is so you're.

Demi : That looks like I'm shooting somebody in that picture, but actually, I just was playing with a camera.

Ellen : You're just holding the camera. You they're beautiful pictures. And you have really been very out spoken about body image and that young women should kind of be proud of their bodies and not be ashamed. And you credit the Kardashians with helping you a lot. And how is that?

Demi : Yeah, well, when I was growing up, at the kind of age where your body starts changing and you want to be cool, it was in the era of when very thin people were the popular people in Hollywood. So that's what I had to look up to. And after having had my issues with

eating, looking to, I want to be the difference for people growing up, because I wish that somebody had gone to me whenever I was 12 13 and said, hey, you don't have to look like that to be cool. And when the Kardashians came on the scene, that was the first time that I really associated curves with beauty, and it was just so new to me. And I remember thinking, wow, that's so cool. And even in a time where I was still struggling with food, I was able to look at Kim's curves and be like, I should really be proud of my curves. And because of that and now, obviously, there's tons of beautiful curvy women out there, but it made me feel more confident in my skin to do that Vanity Fair shoot.

Ellen : Yeah, well, first of all, you look beautiful, and I think that there are more people that are represented on television now. I don't think not nearly enough. But the most important thing that the message that we should be sending young girls and young boys is be healthy. It doesn't matter, really, what your weight is. Just be healthy. That's the most important thing.

Demi : When I did the shoot for Vanity Fair, I said, I want it to be real. I want it to be authentic. And so we did no clothes, no makeup, and no photoshop.

Ellen : Wow, that's a quick shoot.
