

APPENDIX 7 TRANSCRIPT OF INTERVIEW

Student 1

Researcher: hello, my name is okha. Relate to my research about paraphrasing, I need your hand. I'm going to interview yourself as my object.

Student: oh hello, my name is sri rahayu. Of course, I can help you.

Researcher: ok. There are five question I'm going to ask, start for the first question. Are you familiar with paraphrasing skill?

Student: yes, I know that skill.

Researcher: next, have you learned the appropriate way to write a paraphrase? And do you know that inappropriate paraphrasing may lead you to plagiarism?

Student: yes, I've learned and also, I really understand inappropriate paraphrasing may lead us to plagiarism

Researcher: do you know how to paraphrase English text correctly? The criteria for good and poor paraphrasing?

Student: yes, I know but just little bit and I don't know the criteria for good or poor paraphrasing

Researcher: what are the difficulties in paraphrasing English text into your writing?

Student: sometimes I don't understand the English text that I will paraphrase, so I translate it to Bahasa, and that makes me easier to understand.

Researcher: the last, how do you deal with the difficulties of paraphrasing in writing?

Student: I will learn again how to paraphrase correctly and probably, the lecturer gives us more tips or tricks about paraphrasing, moreover in English text.

Student 2

Researcher: Are you familiar with paraphrasing skill?

Student: Yes, I do. I know paraphrasing since I learned to write. Paraphrasing means formulating someone else's ideas in your own words. To paraphrase a source, you have to rewrite a passage without changing the meaning of the original text.

Researcher: Have you learned the appropriate way to write a paraphrase? Do you know that inappropriate paraphrasing may lead to plagiarism?

Student: Yes, I do. Writing technique is another way to avoid plagiarism when writing a book is to do indirect quotations. Quoting indirectly can be realized in some forms, namely paraphrasing, summarizing or drawing conclusion. So we used paraphrasing to avoid plagiarism

Researcher: Do you know how to paraphrase English text correctly? the criteria for good and poor paraphrasing?

Student: The criteria of good paraphrasing; Start your first sentence at a different point from the original source, use synonyms to replace the original word, Change the sentence structure, Break the information into separate sentence, the most important thing is we must use our own words and don't copy the original.

Researcher: What are the difficulties in paraphrasing English text into your writing?

Student: The difficulties in paraphrasing is I must change structures of ideas, change the words, change word order, change sentence structures, lack of vocabulary, and lack of knowledge of paraphrasing.

Researcher: How do you deal with the difficulties of paraphrasing in writing academically?

Student: To deal with the difficulties of paraphrasing we must use some technique like using synonym, changing the sentence patterns, changing the Word form, changing clause and phrase and we have to keep the length approximately the same as the original text. And try to learn more about how to make a good paraphrasing so we can solve the difficulties problem.

Student 3

Researcher: Are you familiar with paraphrasing skill?

Student: Yes, I am.

Researcher: Have you learned the appropriate way to write a paraphrase? Do you know that inappropriate paraphrasing may lead to plagiarism?
