P :Thank you so much, Eliza. You reply really means a lot to me. I guess we should start by now.

So, my first question is, how long is Justin Bieber's involvement in the organization? Because as far as I know, he started to involve in 2010 when he became Spokesperson, and finally he became the Global Ambassador in 2016. I found many of his helps before he became the ambassador. But, I couldn't find his role after he became one. So, I'm still curious about his acts at that time. And I couldn't find the time where he stops work with PoP so I'm confused about what I should write on my thesis about his timeline with PoP.

N1 :Hi Junisya,

Can I ask where you got any initial information about Justin Bieber & PoP in Laos? He went on a trip to our offices in Guatemala, but as far as I know, he didn't have any direct relationship with our programs in Laos other than having a school build in Xong Ja dedicated to him in 2015. He is also no longer a global ambassador; his relationship with Pencils of Promise has not really continued past 2016.

P : Hello Eliza

Oh, right! I'm so sorry I forgot Americans are busy with the US elections.

Hmm, long short story, I was about to put all of the target countries (Laos, Guatemala, Ghana and Nicaragua) on my thesis but my lecturer recommended me to just choose one target country So, I only choose Laos. But he said that I can change the country if I feel more confident with the other country to be my topic.

Do you have any recommendation which country that I should actually choose for my thesis?

I saw a lot of Justin's action actually. How he donated \$1 on every ticket sold at one of his shows in Purpose Tour. Went to the charity GALA on 2011, I guess? And participated in one of PoP's campaign #School4All. But I see that he did all of that actions before he became the ambassador on 2016.

So, the conclusion is Justin didn't really have that much role after he's chosen to be the ambassador? Am I right?

N1: Justin virtually attended the 2018 gala, but yeah, not as much of a role post-2016. I don't think I can make a recommendation on a specific country; donations from his campaigns went to schools in all PoP countries, there wasn't really a preference towards one area.

What information are you looking for from a PoP employee? It seems like you have a record of all of Justin's involvement, so I'm not sure what else we can add.

P: Do you have a list of PoP's campaigns and programs? I'm not sure if I know a lot about PoP's program actually. I only know about School4All and WASH programs but in general.

I want to know more about the School4All campaign but the website is deleted and I couldn't find a credible source about it so if PoP has a report about that campaign I would really appreciate it.

N1 : Junisya,

I think <u>our website</u> would be a great resource; you can read about our 3 primary programs (<u>school builds</u>, <u>teacher support</u>, and <u>WASH</u>), learn how people get involved with PoP (<u>page 1</u> & <u>page 2</u>), <u>read personal accounts</u> from PoP staff and supporters all over the world, and check out some more of <u>our press</u> (which may help with the celebrity aspect of your thesis). I would also take a look at <u>our public Tableau page</u> for data and statistics on our programs and the areas we partner with.

The Schools 4 All campaign finished before I started working with PoP, so I can't give you a lot of historical information. I can tell you it raised over \$308,615 between (I believe) 2015 and 2018, but I'm asking around to see if I can get anything else for you.

Let me know if you have any other questions!

P: This is great, thank you so much Eliza. Let me know if you have any information about the School4All campaign.

- P : Wow, I'm speechless. You're really helping me. Thank you so much Eliza!! It really means a lot to me.
- P : Good morning, Eliza.

I have another question, is there any reason why PoP chose the target country especially Laos?

And also, may I know a list of Justin Bieber's donation for the organization?

Thank you.

To answer your questions:

- 1. Our founder, Adam Braun, was traveling in Southeast Asia in the 2000s and found out that because Laos is a landlocked country, it was least "developed" in the region and by far the least saturated with international aid. Our partnership with Lao communities and the Lao government was officially established in 2009 -- it was the first country PoP partnered with (followed by Guatemala in 2010 and Ghana in 2012). To give you some context, Pencils of Promise focuses on 4 major factors when considering a new country partnership:
- a. Does the country display **measurable need**? (Basically, do the residents of that country need/would they benefit from our help?)
- b. Is the country willing to invest in the future of education? (This is often assumed to be a requirement solely for the government of that country, but it's also important that the members of the communities want to invest in the future of education -- ensuring this has made it possible for ALL of the schools PoP has partnered with across 14 years to still be in operation!)
- c. Is the country **socially and politically stable**? (This goes back to our mission of sustainability -- socially/politically unstable countries may display measurable need, but we cannot guarantee that it will be safe for students to continue to attend the schools we partner with.)
- d. Is the country **under- or over-saturated with NGOs**? (If a country has no experience with international nonprofits, its residents have no reason to trust us and the government may not know how to facilitate programs effectively, causing lots of delays and miscommunications. If a country has "too many" international aid groups on the ground, there can be an overlap of services, which also makes programs less effective.)
- 2. Our records show that Justin Bieber has donated \$60,000 directly, but as you know he helped raise much more through his campaigns.

I know this was a lot more information than you asked for, sorry! Let me know if you have any other questions.

P: Hello, Eliza. It's been a while since I asked you questions about PoP.
I actually have some questions to ask again because I've been continuing my thesis again.

My question is, does PoP has a target area for school they will build? I mean, I take a look at World Bank Data where Laos had 71% rural areas in 2008-2009 and I'm just guessing if PoP has more focus to build school in rural areas than urban areas because that's was I'm going to write in my thesis.

Thank you so much and have a nice day!

Good to hear from you!

We work in areas that are not oversaturated with aid and the cities in which we headquarter are not where other aid organizations generally work. We aim to serve regions that are not already being served by others, which is why our work is mostly rural.

We partner with local Ministries of Education in Ghana, Guatemala, and Laos to identify communities with a high need for investment in infrastructure. After getting a community list from the government, PoP staff members visit each site and conduct due diligence surveys to understand the qualitative and quantitative need for a new school build, reporting back to the local government where we would like to build based on need. Once this list is finalized, we work closely with each community to understand their specific needs. Together, we build new school infrastructure over the course of 3-8 months (depending on the country) and formally hand the school off to both the local government and the community.

I'm also attaching a PDF on the processes and goals for all our partnerships that may be helpful.

P : This is great, thank you so much Eliza!

I have another questions. Does Justin actually has any role or involvement after he became the global ambassador? Since my thesis title is telling about his role when he became one. I found a lot of his role but that was all before he became the GA. It means a lot to me.

- N1: You're right, his actions definitely slowed down after becoming an ambassador in 2016 (I don't even have any specific examples to share with you). He did virtually attend the 2018 gala, though!
- P: May I know how much he donated money from the "\$1 of every ticket will be donated to PoP"?? I guess he donated from each tour (My World Tour, Believe Tour and Purpose Tour)

Based on our records, the funds we received from Justin's concerts amounted to:

2010 - \$425,260.88

2012 - \$431,418.19

2013 (January) - \$192,944.18

2013 (Summer) - \$393,469.15

2016 - \$819,680.54

P : Thank you so much Eliza!

Does PoP also build secondary schools? Or you guys are just focusing on building primary schools?

- N1 : Only primary schools!
- P : I have another questions.
 - May I know how the organization choose the GA?
 - How long can someone be the GA?
 - Who is (or are) the current GA? (And who have became the GA before?)
- N1 : Hi Junisya,

Meadow Walker is our current GA; Justin Bieber and Sophia Bush are both former GAs, but you can probably find more names on our website's <u>blog</u> and <u>press</u> pages. There isn't a specific list of criteria, but GAs are typically individuals who have supported Pencils of Promise for a long time and have an international presence or reach.

- P : Great, thanks!! By the way, I'm sure I've seen Nicaragua as PoP's target country too in your report. Did you guys stop working there?
- N1: Yep! I'm not sure what years we were in operation there, but I do know that all 20 schools that were built in Nicaragua are still in use by the communities there.

P : Hi, Eliza

May I know how much does PoP spend to build a school? It doesn't have to be specific because of course every school has their own expense. I need a range or maybe you can tell me how much cost (cheapest and most expensive) PoP had spend (especially in Laos)

Thank you

N1 : The current average cost of a school build is \$50,000 USD.

P: Hi, Eliza. It's me again.

Do you know any information about how Justin Bieber got involved in PoP for the first time? Like when did he and Adam Braun first talked about it, any exact time that conversation held, or his first ever role in the organization.

Thank you.

N1 : Hi Junisya,

I don't know any of those specifics, I just know that Justin became involved through his manager, Scott "Scooter" Braun, who is Adam's brother. They've done a couple interviews together, including this one.

P: Oh, I see. Thank you!

Also, I saw a post where Justin said that #Schools4All campaign helped to build 14 school. How many schools were built in Laos?

N1: That exact data isn't available, but I can tell you that 12 schools were built in Laos between July 2011 and July 2012, so any of the schools funded by that campaign contributed to the number.

P : Hello, Eliza. I started to continue my thesis again so I gotta ask questions again.

May I know the reason why PoP doesn't work with Nicaragua anymore?

Thanks!

We closed our office in Nicaragua in 2013 for a number of reasons, one of which was to maximize the impact we were making in Guatemala. After closing our office, we continued to donate money to a local nonprofit organization to support the 19 primary schools and 1 secondary school that we had built/partnered with, and all 20 of them are still in operation today.

P: Hi, Eliza. Do you have any information about Ya Laoxayda's profile? Maybe about his background before PoP and how does he become the part of PoP. I found all of the information about Bolom's, Keosuvan's and Gobah's but couldn't find one about Laoxayda

And please explain in general about PoP Gala. Because I would like to write about "Celebrity's Involvement" on my thesis and believe that PoP Gala is attended by many celebrities every year. Thank you so much!

I'm guessing you could find more information about our Gala online through news articles than anything I could share with you. <u>This</u> is this year's Gala page on our website, but if you just Google "Pencils of Promise gala" you'll get lots of results on celebrity attendees throughout the years.

P : Thank you so much for the info!

I found several ways for celebrities to contribute in PoP. There are donating (on their own behalf), making campaigns, and go to the PoP Gala, spread words on social media?? But I guess these are not enough, please tell me more if I miss something!

- N1 : Sorry, what information are you looking for? Yes, our celebrity supporters tend to do all those things
- P : No worries. I think what I mentioned are enough to put on my thesis!

But, can you explain what 501(c)(3) organization is?

P : Hi, Eliza. Is <u>schools4all.org</u> an archived web so maybe I can get an access?

Sorry, I missed your previous email! <u>This website</u> has a pretty good definition for a 501c3 org:

501(c)(3) organizations are nonprofit groups with a dedicated mission. Most people are familiar with them as churches and charities, but they also include private foundations. As long as they operate to support their mission, they receive favorable tax treatment, such as avoiding federal income and unemployment taxes.

And no, I'm not sure that was ever an active website; lots of organizations buy domain names that are similar to their org name, names of specific campaigns, things like that to avoid external impersonations and fraud. If it was an actual webpage, it hasn't been active for quite a few years so I have no access to it.

P : Hello Eliza, sorry for asking too many questions.

I really need to know where the money from the Schools4All campaign goes for each country especially Laos.

I saw that Schools4All 2011 campaign could build 14 schools and Schools4All 2013 could build 15 schools. Are those money went to build schools equally or just for one specifically?

Thank you.

N1 : Hi Junisya,

PoP follows an unrestricted funding model, meaning that all donations go into a general "bucket", and money is dispersed from there to programs/countries/etc. as needed. The amount of money raised may be enough to build x number of schools, but that raised money goes into the bucket and the money to build the schools is taken out, so there's no way of knowing if it's the same exact donations.

P : Thank you for answering my questions.

But, can you give me the estimation of school that could be built from the money Justin donated from his tour? I believe PoP does increase their budget periodically to build school.

For example, from my perspective, when My World Tour started (around 2010) PoP needed \$25,000 to build one school (correct me if i'm wrong) so when he donated \$425,260.88 that means PoP could build 17 schools.

Then, how much the amount of money of PoP's budget to build school on 2012-2013 (Believe Tour era)? Was is still on \$25,000 like 2010 or more?

N1 : I believe the global school build cost was \$25,000 in 2012-2013.

P : Thank you so much for the info.

I found out that there was actually an announcement about \$1 of Believe Tour's tickets will be donated to PoP.

"\$1.00 from each ticket will be donated to Pencils of Promise, a charity which works to build schools and increase educational opportunities in the developing world. The goal is to build 15 schools around the world for needy children. Details at www.pencilsofpromise.com"
